The CT Alliance of YMCAs is comprised of 20 YMCAs including 16 branches and over 28 program sites. Each YMCA is volunteer led. The Alliance is a powerful advocate for the needs of children, families, and individuals in communities throughout Connecticut.

YMCAs across Connecticut provided over \$4.4 million dollars in financial assistance to support youth, adults and families who choose to participate in YMCA programs that promote Youth Development, Healthy Living and Social Responsibility.

The YMCA provides opportunities for youth, adults and families to build stronger bonds, achieve greater work/life balance, and become more engaged with their communities.



- 19,384 children supported through 116 afterschool/enrichment programs
- 12,964 children enrolled in 38 Early Childcare programs
- 41,000 children made life-long friendships at summer camp
- 195,191 members engaged in values-based programs
- 3,285 full-time and part-time employees making a difference
- 4,585 volunteers strengthening communities
